South West Victorian SEAL Inc. is a not-for-profit community based organisation, which started in 1976 in a small section of its current home in Hyland Street Warrnambool, as a Self-Education and Learning Facility, staffed by volunteers with a charter to share knowledge within the community.

It was officially recognised in 1983 when it became an Adult Community Education, provider (now referred to as Learn Local), providing a unique, community-based context for learning. South West Victorian SEAL Inc. is the largest Learn Local provider in the region, taking a lead role in the delivery of services and support to other Learn Local providers across Moyne and Corangamite Local Government areas.

The organisation offers support to a range of students who require a more personalised experience not offered in larger more traditional educational facilities.

RTO status was added in 1992, and South West Victorian SEAL Inc. now boasts offices in both Warrnambool and Hamilton, offering educational services and community support across regional Victoria.

Learn local organisations are governed by voluntary committees of management whose members are drawn from the local community

This is an honorary position and we anticipate that people interested in becoming a member of the committee of management will be able to demonstrate:

- Sound communication and collaboration skills
- Commitment to high ethical standards and teamwork
- High levels of integrity
